Let's Stuff that Bus!

The 37th annual Stuff-A-Bus Food Drive is here! Every year we partner with CityLink and Kroger to collect enough non-perishable food items to fill a CityLink bus. This month we kicked off the 2024 Stuff-A-Bus campaign at the Peoria Kroger on Lindbergh. The morning included representative speakers from CityLink, Kroger, and Peoria Friendship House, a performance by the Coach Bre Cottage cheer team, and the presenting of a donation from Kroger to kick off the food drive!

This year's campaign will run through December 3, and our goal is to collect 12 tons of food in that time. Food will be collected at participating Kroger's in the area, as well as at various partnering schools, churches, and businesses who will host food drives within their own organizations. All food collected will be used to fill our food pantry, which provides an average of 150,000 meals to families in the community every year. We would like to extend a huge thank you to CityLink and Kroger for hosting and sponsoring this campaign.
