### That's A Wrap!

This month we wrapped up our 37th annual Stuff-A-Bus food drive campaign in partnership with Peoria CityLink. The campaign ran from October 18th through December 3rd, and in that time we collected over 10 tons, or 20,000 pounds, of food donations. These donations will go towards servicing our food pantry, which provides an average of 400 meals weekly to those in need in the Peoria community.

The Stuff-A-Bus campaign ended with a press conference in collaboration with CityLink, where we were joined by the Peoria Rivermen and Peoria Mustangs hockey teams to help unload the 10 tons of food donations from the Stuff-A-Bus CityLink bus. In the weeks following the campaign we were joined by various volunteer groups and organizations who assisted in sorting and packaging the food donations. Thank you to everyone who dedicated their time and energy to this project!

We would also like to extend a tremendous thank you to CityLink and Kroger for making the Stuff-A-Bus campaign possible. Together we can create lasting change in Peoria!
